Dear Parnassus Neighbors:

In 1976, the Regents of the University of California made a commitment to neighbors of the UC San Francisco Parnassus campus to limit development of the campus to 3.55 million gross square feet. Known as the "space ceiling," UCSF's development limits mean that to make way for groundbreaking new research buildings like the Regeneration Medicine Building, some older buildings will be torn down or repurposed in the coming years.

In September, UCSF will demolish the building located at 374 Parnassus Avenue and then create open space by landscaping the lot with shrubs and other greenery. There will also be a seating area and lighted stairs included in the project, which will be designed by Byrens Kim Design Works.

We invite you to attend a neighborhood meeting to meet the architect and review the proposed design for the new space.
