

Dear neighbors of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Kirkham,

This letter is to inform you that UCSF is committed to the following actions over the life of the LRDP, several of which affect you. Because there is some doubt about the level of commitment in the LRDP, we are writing this letter to make clear the policy measures we are taking to minimize impact on the neighborhood while we work together to accommodate UCSF's growth.

### **Truck bays**

We are committing to the reduction of truck bays accessible through the residential intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> Ave and Kirkham St. We are committing to building no new truck bays, continuing to support our centralized delivery plan at Mission Bay, adding two truck bays at the western end of UC Hall, and demolishing the Koret Eye Clinic and the two truck bays associated with it.

We will not upgrade any other truck bays accessible by 5<sup>th</sup> Ave and Kirkham to accommodate larger vehicles.

### **Traffic Calming**

Because we have been offered the flexibility of using demolished space for contractor vehicles, we plan to do so. This increase in traffic will affect quality of life around the 5<sup>th</sup> Ave and Kirkham St intersection. We are committed to fully funding the traffic calming plan collaboratively created with the 5<sup>th</sup> and Kirkham neighbors and submitted to the SFMTA.
